

Beloved, it is not just a FEELING. You are in a battle! A blood-n-guts, hand-to-hand, heart-to-heart conflict. - ▼ To rest...to find God's rest!
- ▼ To strategize...to find God's plan and let God equip us for our purpose!
- ▼ To re-supply...to refuel on joyfulness, God's Word, and real live encouragement! To put on new armor!

May we come apart today so that God can reach down deep within to the *hidden woman of the heart* to revive our hearts, minds, and souls!

A Virtuous Woman
Turn to Proverbs 31: 10
Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price is far above rubies.
What is your idea of a virtuous woman? What comes to mind? Is there a person that comes to your mind? What do you think makes her virtuous?
Do you ever get to feeling a bit overwhelmed at the thought of being a virtuous woman? Why do you think this is overwhelming?
I think I have some help here. I, myself, get SO overwhelmed by the image in my mind of what constitutes a godly, virtuous woman. It has helped me so much more to find out what God means in His descriptions of a virtuous woman. Beginning with the definitions of what the word even means
Have you ever looked up the meaning of Virtuous ? Look it up in a dictionary and write the definition below

Virtue...

strength; bravery; valor; strength of mind in regard to danger; that quality that enables a man to encounter danger with firmness; personal bravery; courage; intrepidity; prowess; moral goodness; the practice of moral duties and abstaining from vice, or conformity of life and conversation to the moral law; moral excellence; acting power; excellence; that which constitutes value and merit; power; authority.

The picture here is that true virtue includes: goodness, right actions, right thinking, purity, clean in heart, soul, and body, having a moral way, having POWER, AUTHORITY, INFLUENCE!

Virtuous...

Comes from the Hebrew word chayil (khah-yil) meaning:

a force whether of men, means or other resources; an army (soldiers) company, (great) forces, goods, host, might, power, riches, strength, strong, substance, train, valiant, valiantly, valour, virtuous, virtuously, war, worthy, worthily.

Now, this gets good! Let's look deeper at this definition. Which words surprise you?


How is this definition different from your perspective of what a woman is to be like?

How are you matching up?

*	Are you an army? God does not get glory from a WEAK woman (emotional, whiny, conforming) OR from a militant woman (selfish, controlling, take charge). He wants a woman ready for BATTLE: strong, prepared, dependent upon Him. What areas do you need to work on to become a strong army?
•	Are you disciplined? Can the heart of your husband TRUST in you??? No spoil? What about money? No debt? Know that \$\$ is God's money! Does God want for you to have it? Don't presume the future! Can your husband trust you to be LOYAL and FAITHFUL in your moralitytongueattitude?? Can it be said of you that you do HIM good and not evil ALL the days of your life? Are you building him?? Promoting him?? Or looking for a back door to divorcetaking care of self?? How are you doing here?
•	Where is your courage? Where do you run when you are weak? How do you handle your foes?
•	Do you yield to your godly authority? Even when it means you may suffer? Especially when you have a different plan?

Turn to Matthew 1: 1-17... Take a look at the women mentioned in the passage. Here is a little background...


- ▼ Tamar...widow (2 times); childless; incestuous background BY HER CHOICE (she allured and seduced her father-in-law)!

- ▼ Ruth...widow left without children; bad upbringing; bad family; idolator!
- "Uriah's Wife"...committed adultery WITH the King; assisted in murdering her own husband to cover it up!

Now, beloved, think about them. We have a tendency to not mention the "black sheep" in our families. Oh, thank God that HE is not like us! God NOT ONLY used them, but called them faithful and listed them specifically in the lineage of Jesus!

What about you? Where have you been? What is your secret? What have you done? Who has stared at you in disgust and judgment? Do you find that you would really rather not have your story written because you are not quite sure you want others to know that you came from a family such as yours? Would you rather hide away in obscurity not sharing your deepest, darkest secrets? Would you rather forget those moments when you made those mistakes that still send shivers all over your body as you feel the pang of humiliation and disappointment in the depths of your heart? Do you think that God surely can't use you...that He has made a mistake choosing you as a mother of your precious children...and that you are not sure you are up for the call even now?

There is one great thing about our great God...He can use any of us!

Get to Know God (and His Names)...

Psalm 9:10...

And they that know Thy name will put their trust in Thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek Thee."

His Name has power! In the Name of God there is power. What power have you seen His Name to have in your life?

The name of God has the power to save! To set free! To minister to the depths of your heart and soul! What do you need today?

His name reveals His Character! You can count on Him to BE what He is called! Whatever your need, He can minister to your heart, soul, and mind just because of WHO He is. Look at the following names of God. Jot down how that name has ministered to you in the past OR how it could minister to you today...

He is I AM for ALL that we need!

Elohim (God)...This name means Mighty Creator, Giver of life. He knows each and every person from the foundation of the world. He knows exactly what each of us needs. He knows exactly where we are going and what our life holds before us. Elohim is the only One that can bring LIFE. He is the One Who takes our life and transforms it into abundant life! How have you seen Elohim work in your life? How has God ministered to you or how can He minister to you as Elohim?

El Elyon...This is the name that means The Most High. As The Most High, God delivers enemies into

our hand (In Genesis 14:20 He delivered Abraham's enemies into his hand!). He is the Redeemer (He can give you back lost groundlost time!). He rules today in all affairs. (Got a tough situation you need for Him to control?) El Elyon, is the God Who has all we need to do anything. He wants to give you all that you need in abundance. El Elyon has complete Sovereignity—He has THE Plan. He sends you exactly where He plans, but never by yourselfHe is in this with you! How have you seen the hand of El Elyon in your life? How has He ministered to you as El Elyon in the past? How could He minister to you as El Elyon today?
El RoiThis name is means the God Who Sees. (Remember the story of Hagar? Alone, did what she was commanded to do by her authorities, suffering for obediencebut not alone! God was there and He did see!). This name assures us that He is there and His eyes are not shut! Have you ever been in a situation that you felt no one could see the whole truth of what happened? God was there and HE saw it all. How does that comfort you? How can that comfort you today?
El ShaddaiThis name means All-sufficient One, Protector, Sustainer of life, Unconditional Lover of my soul. It is El Shaddai, Who holds us through the hard times. He is our Refuge during toughest days. He is All-Bountiful, full of blessings. He is there to quiet the restless and give life, abundant life. Just when we think we cannot make it, El Shaddai pours Himself and His Spirit out for us. He gives Himself and His Very Nature to us freely! Seen El Shaddai in your life? How could your situation change today as you pull into El Shaddai?
AdonaiThis is the name of God that we probably MOST know about. He is the Lord and Master. However, very few choose to press into this relationship with God. The benefits of being the servant of Adonai are beyond that of any other master. However, Adonai demands TOTAL obedience. Total obedience includes following without knowing the details, the reason, the results, the ramifications, or even the rewards. Have you gotten to know God as Adonai? What is your excuse?

What are some of the benefits of serving Adonai? List some of the benefits from Scripture
IshiThis name is the name that God uses to describe Himself as our Husband. In this name, He commits to a personal relationship with us ETERNALLY. Not a stand-off relationship with an unapproachable God. He commits to a relationship that is intimate, vibrant, and passionate. Need protection, Ishi steps up to the plate. Need provision, once again, your Good Husband provides before you can breathe the request. Need a best friend, oh! There is no better friend. Ishi wants you and wants for you to want Him. Think of your relationship with God
♥ Do you get excited when He calls for you?
♥ Do you soak up every Word He says to you?
▼ Is He your Soul Satisfaction? Is there another you have run to?
◆ Do you know that He wants to hear from you? Anytime? Anywhere? No limits?

◆ Do you know that He also wants and needs to talk to you?
♥ What difference does it make in your life to KNOW that God wants to be known as Ishi, your Husband? How can that change your relationship with Him today?
Jehovah This name simply means I AM or I AM WHO I AM. Confusing? Look a bit deeper. It means I AM ALL you need for me to BE or to BECOME for you. This is probably the name with the deepest meaning. In Jehovah, we see the One, True, Living God. The Self-existent One. The Eternal One. He is Alpha and Omega, which means The Beginning and The End. He is the same in character, personality and commitment yesterday, today, and tomorrow. He ALONE possesses and grants eternal LIFE. All LIFE is in Him and through Him. The name Jehovah means that He is Covenant Keeping. In fact, once His Word has gone out, it cannot change. He, Himself, is our Unchanging God. Faithful to His Word for all generations!
This name is used as a compound name to show many ways and situations in which He can and will BE or BECOME all that you need. Become a Woman of Vision...

Ready? You now know what God means by a virtuous woman. You now know that YOU are called to become one. You also know that the first step is to get to know God and His names. Now what?

In order to become a Virtuous Woman, we also need to become women with vision. Look up Proverbs 29: 18.

Unless we get a vision of what God calls us to be and do, we will cast off restraint and live a life void of purpose and meaning. How can we get an accurate picture of what a Godly Woman is really supposed to be like? What do you think would help?

I would like to propose a couple of ideas to help along the way. First, **get in the Word**. Only the Bible can help you get to KNOW God! As you get to know HIM, you will know His heart and His still, small voice teaching you the way to go. Why do you think this would be necessary for the Virtuous Woman?

The Bible has the power to work in your life. Look up 2 Timothy 3:16-17. What does the Word of God do in our lives...

The Word of God is essential if we are to become Virtuous Women. Only there can we find the teaching that we need to learn how to be a godly woman. Only there can we find a kind rebuke that shows us a higher way to live. Only there can we find correction that can change our view about womanhood. Only in the pages of the dearest Book in the world will we find a training manual that will challenge us to become women of vision, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Another way that we can become women of vision is to study the lives of women in Scripture. There is simply no other resource like the Bible. In the pages of Scripture we are introduced

candidly to women who lived very real lives and every gritty detail of their lives is out on the table laid bare. We see their strengths and their weaknesses. We see all of their qualities, sometimes very good and sometimes very, very bad. Their lives are laid bare, showing us their faults and the things that we can use to pattern our own lives after!
Want a great project? Pick a woman from Scripture. Get to know her. Ask the following questions
♥ Who is she? What is her story?
▼ What were her greatest strengths?
What were her greatest shortcomings?
₩ What were her greatest shot realings?
Did she have a commitment to God? How strong? How could you tell?
What difference did her relationship with God have on those around her?

▼ What principles from her life can change my life?

Develop Spiritual Disciplines

"Thou therefore which teachest another, teachest thou not thyself?"

Romans 2: 21

Ok, ok! Here is where I begin to REALLY meddle! So, DO NOT skip this section!

I know that of all the things I have done in my life, this is the one area that I can tell when I am on target…or I can tell when I am off track. Women are constantly pouring out. We all have a very strong tendency to get so wrapped up in all that we are to do each and every day—growing in godliness, nurturing our marriages, ministering to the hearts of our children, homemaking, ministering to those in our sphere of influence, homeschooling, working—that we neglect time before God to let Him teach us and pour into our empty cups. As a result, we do not have the vibrancy and passion that we could have. We get tired and weary. BUT! God has a better plan!

How does He teach us? How does He pour into us so we will be ready to pour into the lives of others? Through Spiritual Disciplines!

Take a look at the following Spiritual Disciplines. As you look through them, evaluate your own life. Take note of whether you are currently disciplining yourself in this area or not AND what the effects are as you pour forth into those you love...

Rest...

Oh yes! You read right! Rest! I know what you are thinking, it is probably the same thing that first came across my mind, "REST! Could REST be BIBLICAL???" Yes, beloved...take a look at Mark 6: 31. EVEN Jesus rested! Are you thinking, "What is the big deal about rest?" Let's look at this discipline...

Take a look at Exodus 31: 12-17 and Exodus 23:12. In the Old Covenant, there was a DAY OF REST. What did these passages say was the *purpose* of the Day of Rest?

This was a foreshadow of the rest that would come. This rest is now available to us. When Jesus came with the New Covenant, He brought SPIRITUAL REST!

Why? There are several reasons that we find in Scripture. Take a look at the following Scriptures

Are you experiencing rest? God will meet you and build you there. You can shut out the world and enter in! It is there that you will see spiritual and physical dividends. There you will be refreshed!
Quiet Times
