Perhaps this is the reason that we have seen our culture turn their hearts away from our Lord. It does not matter which time of day that you choose to use this study or exactly how you implement the lessons...just that you take time daily to spend time in deep study of God's Word!

Our studies are designed specifically to meet your needs whether you are a student, looking for a good study just for you, or you are a parent, looking for a study just for you! Just mention that you want to purchase a study to go along with your Discipleship Notebook and we will offer them at 20% off through our office! (remind our staff!)

Regardless of what you choose to help you dig into the Word of God, we suggest taking your time to study in great detail. You may choose just one verse a day, looking up words in that verse so you can fully understand that verse. You may choose to dig into the background of a culture, studying history books along with the time period. You may even choose to research Ancient Art or Ancient Music. As you dig deep, you will never regret it!

Why dig deep? First, **we need to practice taking a closer look at the Bible if we are to make it part of our lives.** Secondly, **the Bible is daily food for our growing yet often, weary bodies.** As we chew upon it bit by bit, we find ourselves better prepared for our daily work and all of our daily battles. Also, we find that the deeper we study in our home, **the more that we have to share with one another and others.** It seems that as we study deeper, even my youngest child makes more application and shares more wisdom! This time is truly precious and must be seized before all else that we find ourselves doing each day.

Regardless of the study you choose, I recommend that all studies of Scripture only cover a verse or two a day. If you feel that you can cover more, feel free to do so...but remember that this time of Bible Study is intended to slow you down to really chew on God's Word. If you find these sheets to be too much, take it slower...or just discuss the passage orally. If you prefer, you can even DRAW pictures that will help you to remember your study for the day!

Want an easy way to study through Scripture? During the first few minutes that you sit down, **review** what you have learned up to date. Think through what you remember up to date.

After each review, we encourage *reading through the entire* chapter. This helps to see a complete picture of the passage. It also establishes the habit of looking through the entire passage of Scripture to find answers for daily life! This habit can be used later as you mature to give them ideas for studying deeper.

In our family, we then work on the *Memory Work each day*. Our children use the Memory Verse as Copywork in their Copybooks, Journals, and even on recipe cards. We try to quote our verses every day before each lesson to be sure that God's Word is firmly planted in our hearts. There are more suggestions for Memory Work in that section of our Notebook. Just practice the verse of your choice each day before you begin your study.

One other thing that we have found to be a blessing is keeping *Prayer Lists*. For this reason, we have enclosed a prayer log in its section of this book to jot down requests, dates, and answers during your daily quiet time. Prayer lists are such a precious history of God's Work in the lives of your family! When you find yourself feeling frustrated because some requests just take time to see God move, you will have a record of God's answers and faithfulness in other areas of your life!

So, ready to dig into the Bible? My prayer is that you will find these pages to be a "helper" that goes alongside of you. In no way should these pages become a taskmaster! If you were to join me for my daily quiet time, you would find that so often I do not do the same-old-same-old things! So, dig into the Word and devour each moment you spend with your precious Lord and Saviour! Let the Holy Spirit lead you through each second of your time in the Word! My prayer is that as you study, the Lord will teach you many priceless Truths from God's precious Word while growing each of you closer to Him Step by Step!

Time For Daily Bible Memory!

I know, I know what many of you are thinking! You have tried to memorize Scripture, but you are "challenged" in this area! Nothing has ever frustrated me MORE than my earnest struggle to memorize Scripture. I simply could not do it for so long. Then, it appeared to me to make this need a petition of my prayers. Now, I am learning more and more each day! No Bible Memory drills here! But, God is a God Who cares about the most minute details! He especially wants to help you to hid His Word in your heart.

So, need a little help? That is what this section is for!

Helps for Bible Memorization

These ideas are included to help you as you hide God's Whole Word in Your heart...

- **Make a commitment to learn a certain amount of Scripture each week.** You can work on ONE of your favorite verses FOREVER...but make a commitment to learn a bit each week! I guarantee you will learn more than you ever plan!
- **Be consistent!** Set aside a regular time each day for working on memory work. We usually work on ours individually during our Quiet Times.
- **Have a set time to quote your passages to one another.** Maybe over breakfast...or while running errands in town. Just be sure to share your verse with those you love. You will be surprised how fast you will learn it and how easy it will be to remember it forever! Plus! It may become a favorite of others too!
- **Allow opportunities to quote what they know.** The hardest part is learning your verses, the most fun is quoting it, so make opportunities to quote them! Make it be tickets to go play, to eat dessert...you get the point!
- **Sing Scripture songs.** Steve Green has a great tape for children *Hide 'em in Your Heart*. You can get his or others at your local Christian bookstore. I have also seen many great praise and worship tapes that are filled with Scriptures set to songs. These guarantee immediate results! Get one and enjoy!
- **Memorize passages together.** We are now trying to memorize Psalm 1 together as a family. This makes it easier to quote along the way!
- **Write it out. Keep Bible Journals!** Well, that is what this section is all about!
- **Play games...** Write out Scripture on index cards, one word on each card. Scramble and try to put in order...Write out Scripture Verses on a piece of paper with your words separated enough that you can cut it out into a puzzle, while you are putting it together, see if you can remember what is missing! When swimming, have a race to see who can quote a Scripture first and then race to the other side. You get the idea,

so have fun!

- Let your older children help the younger ones (or YOU!) to memorize verses.
- **Don't know what to memorize?** Try to memorize verses in which you can use for your personal life... Verses to help with specific temptations. (As matter of fact, you may want to make and keep a list of verses related to areas of your weakness and temptation!)... Verses to help encourage you, as well as, your loved ones...Verses for evangelism...Verses which are God's sweet promises.

Make Bible Memory fun! Make Bible Memory a part of your daily Spiritual Disciplines. The fruit is UNBELIEVABLY SWEET!

Time For Prayer!



Prayer is a regular discipline of all great men and women of God! Looking back to Scripture, we see a pattern of regular prayer in the lives of all of the great saints all throughout History.

- ♥ David who was a busy King, prayed morning, noon, and night (Psalm 55:17).
- ♥ The writer of Psalm 119 prayed seven times a day!
- ♥ Daniel, a leader of the great Babylonian Empire and administrator of the Medo-Persian Empire prayed on his knees in his upstairs room three times a day so faithfully that he was CONVICTED and sentenced for the CRIME of praying!! (Daniel 6:10)
- ♥ Isaac was praying in the evening when he first saw Rebekah and fell in love (Genesis 24: 62-65).
- ♥ Peter prayed at noon (Acts 10:9). Oh, that was not all!
- ♥ Peter and John prayed together at the temple in mid-afternoon (Acts 3:1).
- ♥ Jesus prayed early in the morning (Mark 1:35), sometimes at night (Luke 6:12), by withdrawing from crowds...not just when there was a lull in things, but in the thick of things! Jesus even prayed when he could have been sleeping (Luke 5:16).

I am sure that you can find many, many more instances, but that is not the focus here. The focus is that in order to truly become a great man or woman of God, one must have a regular discipline of prayer!

Why? Why do we NEED prayer? Well, as we regularly withdraw to be alone with God in prayer, we are strengthened by God, Himself! Ever feel weak and weary? Ever feel too feeble to do great things for God? Try withdrawing from your life for a little while each day. I guarantee that you will come away with not only strength, but also the inspiration to do the work that God has set aside for you alone! That withdrawal will have another benefit. You will mature much quicker because you will have that renewed mind that God promises! You will understand the things of God. This will help you to turn away from the "busyness" of daily life so you may get an eternal perspective on a daily basis! Withdrawing to God will comfort you in the tough times...give you the security of an intimacy with God in times of loneliness...and give you a passion for Him that will turn our culture upside down!

Sound easy...but, you KNOW it is difficult! I know! There is a battle waged from our enemy to keep us OFF of our knees. If he can't keep us off of our knees, he will keep us from truly communing in prayer! This is the whole goal of this section of our Notebook! I am so excited to be taking your hand to walk with you into your prayer closet!

Forms in the following pages are set up to give you focus in your prayer time. As with all other sections of this Notebook, we are in no way implying that this is THE WAY to pray

or that you are not doing it "right" if you pray differently. Use what works! Have no idea?
Take my hand. Here we go!

Pray Using the Names of God!

If there is ONE thing that has helped me more in my daily life, I would say that it has been getting to know the Names of God, what they mean, and how they can minister to me right in the midst of my struggles!

Why? Why Study The Names of God???

- ♥ **Names have meaning!** Sylvia Gunter wrote in *Prayer Portions*, "How you view God determines how you approach Him or whether you think He is approachable at all. Some Christians relate to Him as Righteous Judge and come before His judgment bench for a review of all their failures. They think God is looking for reasons to zap them. These people seldom come at all because of the condemnation they take on themselves in His presence. Others view Him as strong Sovereign but impersonal, remote, way up there somewhere, busy with big things like war and famine, but not at all involved in the details of their lives. They think that after they have done their best, God may somehow squeeze them into His schedule to take care of the rest. Since God is so busy, messages can be left on His heavenly answering machine and "He'll get back with you as soon as possible." These people miss the blessing of seeing Him in the details of their days. Other Christians entrust their eternal soul to Him for salvation but feel super-responsible and worry about handling the myriad details and decisions of their life, because indeed their earthly father left them to take care of themselves." The Names of God help us to KNOW Him! His names mean peace for our past; help for our day-to-day life; hope for our future.
- ♥ **So we will know where to run!** Proverbs 18:10 is one of my favorite verses in the whole Bible (You may want to choose it as a Memory Verse! HINT!) It says, "**The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the [consistently] righteous man [upright and in right standing with God] runs into it and is safe, high [above evil] and strong.**" Getting to know the names of God will help us to know where to run! HE is where we will find safety! HE is where we will find security! HE is where we will find strength! HE is where we will find power! HE is where we will find hope! HE is where we will find comfort, compassion, mercy! HE is where we will find ALL that we need!
- ♥ **So we will get to KNOW Him!** We must KNOW God to truly LOVE Him! We can't KNOW others without knowing ABOUT one another. A person's character is in their name. Likewise, you can now know God without knowing ABOUT Him. His character is revealed in His names. Each name reveals a different perspective of our relationship with Him. In fact, most of the compound names of God were revealed to us through a crisis situation/incident in the life of a person. They denote WHO He is for the one in crisis! They give us HOPE in the midst of our crisis/trial! They help us to KNOW Him more deeply! His greatest desire is to reveal Himself to us so...
 - ...we can run to Him at any time
 - ...we can know Him
 - ...we can know His power
 - ...we can know His heart

...we can know His character
...we can know His glory!

The entire theme of Scripture is that God wants relationship with us! It is revealed in His names. Just a few of His "relational" names are...

- Mother (Isaiah 40:15)
- Father (Galatians 4:6)
- Husband (Jeremiah 31:32)
- Brother (Proverbs 18:24)
- Lover (Song of Solomon)
- Bridegroom (Revelation 19: 7-9)
- Shepherd (Psalm 23)
- Creator/Designer (Psalm 100:3—created and designed the WHOLE world and ALL in it; Psalm 139—AND me, created and designed me JUST as I am!)
- King (Psalm 10: 16)
- Provider (Matthew 6: 25-33)
- Protector (Jeremiah 20:11)
- Teacher (Psalm 25: 8-12)
- Counselor (Isaiah 9:6)
- Friend (John 15: 14, 15)
- Physician (Matthew 9: 12, 13)
- Master (Luke 16: 13)
- Servant (Mark 10: 45)
- Military Commander (Ephesians 6: 11-18)

♥ **So we can know His ways...** We must know HIS ways and LEARN them if we are to live a life that is pleasing before Him! (Exodus 33: 13) The best way to get to know God's ways is to get to know His names and what they mean!

♥ **So we can bring Him glory...**The word *Glory* means a correct estimate of; correct opinion of; to live in such a way that our lives give others a correct estimate of God; to live our lives in such a way that others have a correct opinion of God. Want to bring Him glory? We must get to KNOW Him if we are to have any idea of the glory in Him. There is no better way than through His Names!

♥ **So we can pray successfully...**We want to know what to pray. We want for our prayers to be answered. God wants the same thing! He wants for us to know HIM deeper and deeper...

- ...as the God for our situation
- ...as our personal God
- ...as the One to run to in all situations we face!
- ...as the One to trust with all of the details!

Then, we can rest knowing that we are truly praying successfully!

- ♥ **So we will have an unshakeable foundation!** We CAN know Him intimately! It is through His Word that we get to know Him! As we get to KNOW Him, we will have more strength for all of our situations. We will have a firm foundation. He will become more intimate; more real! Get to know His names! Get to know His name for YOUR situation! He will answer your heart cry to Him! He will bring you hope IN THE MIDST of your struggle! You will become a woman or man of praise and adoration! You will become a virtuous woman or a valiant man, one who wages war through the Word!
- ♥ **So, we may wage warfare!** Praise IS warfare! Praise His NAME! It is where you tear down your enemy's banners (lies, myths) and raise up the LORD, Your Banner (truth, answers)! It is where you find deliverance and bring glory to God (Psalm 50:15) It's where you find security, protection, and provision (Psalm 20). Want to know how to pray in the midst of your battle? Get to know the Names of God and pray on behalf of the name that will battle FOR YOU!

You CAN Trust His Name!

Isaiah 50: 10 says...**"Let him trust in the name of the Lord and rely upon his God."** Put your trust in the name of God. Put your worries, burdens, your work at His feet. Come to Him. Put your confidence in Him! You won't burn out, get weary, or be disappointed! Let's GET TO KNOW some of His Names! Make them a part of your prayers!

God IS...

- ♥ **Elohim (Hebrew for God)...**means Mighty Creator; Giver of life.
- ♥ **El Elyon...**means Most High; Delivers enemies into our hand (Genesis 14:20), Delivered Abraham's enemies into his hand!); Redeemer; Rules today in all affairs; God Who Has all we need to do anything; One Who wants to give you all in abundance; With Complete Sovereignty—He has THE Plan; He sends you exactly where He plans; He is in this with you
- ♥ **El Roi...**The God Who Sees (Hagar); He is there; His eyes are not shut
- ♥ **El Shaddai...**All-sufficient One; Protector; Sustainer of life; Unconditional Lover of my soul; Holds us through the tough times; Our Refuge on tough days; All-Bountiful; Full of Blessings; Quiets the Restless; Gives Life; Pours Himself and His Spirit out for us; Gives Himself and His very Nature to me
- ♥ **Adonai...**Lord and Master; Demands TOTAL obedience (follow without knowing the details!)
- ♥ **Jehovah...**I AM WHO I AM; Self-existent one; Eternal; Alpha and Omega; Same yesterday, today, and tomorrow; Possesses and Grants eternal LIFE; Covenant Keeping; Unchanging God; All LIFE is in Him; Faithful to His Word for all generations
- ♥ **Jehovah Jireh...**The Lord Who will provide; His very being is to love and give to me; Delights in giving to me!
- ♥ **Jehovah Rapha...**The Lord Who Heals
- ♥ **Jehovah Jireh...**The Lord Who Redeems (brought out of Egypt; fed daily in the

wilderness)

- ♥ **Jehovah Nissi**...The Lord to look to in the battle; The One Who goes before us!
- ♥ **Jehovah Mekoddishkem**...The Lord Who Sanctifies and Makes Holy
- ♥ **Jehovah Shalom**...The Lord OUR Peace!
- ♥ **Jehovah Sabaoth**...The Lord of Hosts; Our Strength; Our Deliverer; Our Refuge; Our Judge; Our Strong Tower;
- ♥ Our Safety; Our Endurance!
- ♥ **Jehovah-Raah**...The Lord our Shepherd; One clear voice/right way-straight narrow way; Brings rest/nourishment/comfort; Gives the best running over; Always with me; Leads in truth
- ♥ **Jehovah-Tsidkenu**...The Lord our Righteousness
- ♥ **Jehovah Shammah**...The Lord is THERE; Bears our load; Gives us step by step direction (cloud by day/night??); Help in the battle; Brings out of captivity; there to bring glory!

He is "I AM" for ALL we need! Need ANYTHING? Use the names of God in your prayers!
